Early of this month. Maersk Advisories said **The unprecedented situation of severe port congestion globally continues to result in accumulation of delays** across several services on the Asia to Med network.

Thev said **This situation is driven by a combination of increased demand. and measures to fight the pandemic across ports and supply chains in general.** These accumulated delays are currently causing further gaps in the schedules and have resulted in several Asia departures been spread apart by more than 7 days.

▲ Opportunities are always for those who are well prepared.


